Term 2 Weeks 1 - 5



Religious Education

We will be exploring the 'Confirmation' unit of work.



Maths

We will be covering the following topics in Mathematics:
Factors, reading scales, measuring capacity, measuring mass, making a table/chart, measuring perimeter, measuring area and describing possible outcomes.

HASS

In Geography, we will be exploring the importance and connection of the environment to animals, natural resources and sustainability.



Literacy



Reading: The students will read and analyse different creative texts. They will construct different types of questions in response to the various authors, illustrators and characters explored.

Writing: The students will be learning how to structure and write narratives. They will learn skills to improve their creative writing.

Health

In Keeping Safe we will be exploring relationships and trust networks.
