## Term 2 Weeks 7-11

### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

We are working through our unit on PRAYER.

We are learning that people can pray to:

- say thank you to God
- give praise to God
- say sorry to God for the ways they do not follow the teachings of Jesus

### ENGLISH

**Writing:** In Writing we are learning how to write persuasive texts. The children are learning about the text structure and language features of persuasive texts. Ask your child to persuade you to let them stay up late!

**Phonics:** In Phonics we are currently learning the /er/sound - as in, **g**ir**l**, **t**ur**n**, **w**or**d**, **v**er**b**, **l**ear**n**. In weeks 9 and 10 we will be learning the /e/ sound - as in **s**ai**d**, **w**en**t**, **t**re**a**d, **f**rie**n**d. We continue to revise the digraphs - ch, sh, th, wh, ng, ck and the spellings we have learnt to represent the /ae/, /ee/ and /oe/ sounds.

**Reading:** In whole class reading we are looking at Persuasive Texts and Narratives. We are learning about the features of these text types and encouraging the children to make connections to their own lives.



## MATHEMATICS

In NUMBER we are learning about addition and subtraction. We are learning a number of different strategies, including make ten, near ten, doubles, add/subtract zero and part-part-total.

In MEASUREMENT & GEOMETRY we are learning about length. We will be comparing length using informal units (blocks, paper clips, etc).

In STATISTICS & PROBABILITY we are learning about collecting data by asking questions.

## GEOGRAPHY

In Geography we are learning about the features of places. Features can be natural, managed and constructed. We will be looking at the location of features on a pictorial map and discussing how they change over time and how they can be cared for.
