Term 2 Weeks 6 - 11



Religious Education

We will be exploring the 'Eucharist' unit of work.



Maths

We will be covering the following topics in Mathematics:
Addition, subtraction, rounding, estimating, fractions, grid references, angles, algorithms and types of graphs.

Literacy



Reading: The students will read and explore informative texts that link to our learning in HASS.

Writing: The students will be learning how to structure and write informative texts. They will learn skills to improve their informative writing.



HASS

In Geography, we will be exploring the main characteristics of the continents of Africa and Europe, and the location of their major countries in relation to Australia.



Digital Technologies

Students will learn the basics of coding. Using Scratch, they will create a game that shows how they can overcome daily hazards at school.

Health

In Keeping Safe we will be exploring respectful relationships and power in relationships.

In Friendology, we will be learning about being an inviter, trust and respect in action and standing up for yourself.
